Located at the western end of Water Street

**HEATHER MOYSE PARK** - Nourish yourself with nature and botanical gardens! Heather Moyle Park, named after Summerside's two-time Olympic Gold Medal Champion, is full of native shrubbery and indigenous plantings. Open year-round, it is perfect for walking, biking, cross country skiing, bird watching and time well spent in nature. The main entrance of HMP is located at the intersection of Eustane and Ottawa Streets.

**ROTARY FRIENDSHIP PARK** - Absorb yourself in the 64-acre tree plotted clay trails Rotary Friendship Park has to offer. The Trails will showcase the diverse terrain found amongst the Island. 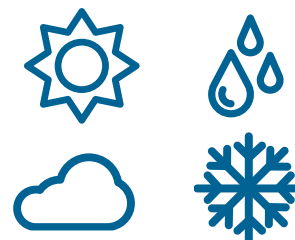
