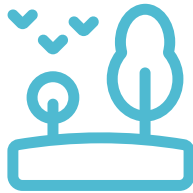
## Rich History, Art and Culture

From outdoor murals and live music to heritage properties and historic homes; however, you like to interact with culture and heritage, Summerside has something to offer.



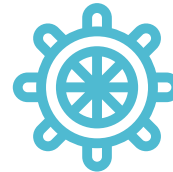
## Unique Company
